

ENDWELL FAMILY PHYSICIANS ROUTINE INFANT/CHILD/ADOLESCENT VACCINE SCHEDULE

Birth dose of Hepatitis B given in the hospital

2 Months: Vaxelis #1(Dtap, Inactivated Polio, Haemophilus Influenzae b, Hepatitis B), Rotateq #1 (Rotavirus), Prevnar 20 #1 (Pneumococcal)

4 Months: Vaxelis #2, Rotateq #2, Prevnar 20 #2

6 Months: Vaxelis #3, Rotateq #3, Prevnar 20 #3

12 Months: MMR #1 (Measles Mumps Rubella) and Varicella #1 (Chicken Pox), Vaqta #1 (Hepatitis A)

15 Months: ActHiB #4 (Haemophilus Influenzae b), Prevnar 20 #4

18 Months: Vaqta #2, Daptacel #4 (Dtap)

4-6 years (entering Kindergarten): Quadracel (Dtap #5 and Inactivated Polio #4) and Proquad (MMR #2 and Varicella #2)

9 years: Gardasil #1

10 years: Gardasil #2 if not given sooner

11 years (entering 6th grade): Adacel (Tdap) and MenQuadfi (Meningitis)

Adacel can be given at 10 years of age to meet school requirement.

16 years (entering their senior year): MenQuadfi #2

If your child is sick during a routine physical, a nurse visit can be scheduled as soon as they are well.
